Jindera Golf Club - Addendum to "Local Rules"

Electric Fences – If the electric fences along the left-hand side and behind the greens on the 2nd-11th and 6th-15th interfere with the players stance or stroke, the player must take a free drop of one club length from the nearest point of <u>complete relief</u> no nearer to the hole as defined by **Rule 16.1 A & B.** This rule does not apply if the ball comes to rest in a penalty area or out of bounds – in which case a penalty drop must be taken.

On the green – If the alternate hole, or a ripple (not join) interferes with the line of the players putt, the player may take a free relief at the nearest point of complete relief no nearer to the hole as defined by **Rule 16.1 D.** If the ball comes to rest <u>on</u> a join, the player may move the ball to the nearest point that it is no longer in contact with the join and no closer to the hole.

The edge of the green – If the ball comes to rest on the lip or the edge of the green or the lip or edge of the green interferes in the players swing, the player may take relief by placing the ball off the green with in one club length and no nearer to the hole. As referenced in rule 1.2.4 for Special Rule for Australian Sand Greens Courses.

Preferred Lie – Exists all year round. The ball may be moved no more than one card length, to a position no closer to the hole in order to improve the lie, provided the ball is not in a hazard area, or on the green.

Etiquette – The lowest marker is responsible for etiquette in their group.

Penalty for break of local rule – Match Play – Loss of Hole. Stroke Play – Two strokes.

Out of Bounds – Rule E5 is observed at our club – Option to taking "Stroke and Distance" is to drop ball on fairway up to 2 club lengths adjacent to where ball is estimated to be out of bounds/lost - no closer to hole with a 2 Stroke Penalty.
